Speaking to news agency ANI, Priyanka Gandhi Vadra said, "There is no point stopping us on road. It's not an issue of SPG but of Uttar Pradesh Police." Priyanka Gandhi had earlier visited Bijnor on Sunday to meet families of the victims of the anti-CAA clashes. The UP Police had, however, stopped Priyanka and Rahul Gandhi from entering Meerut to meet families of those killed in the violence. "We asked the police to show us order, but they did not show any order for stopping us and told us to return," Rahul Gandhi told reporters. According to a police statement, Rahul and Priyanka Gandhi were served a notice which said section 144 of the CrPC has been imposed and the situation in Meerut was sensitive. "They were told that they will be held responsible for any deterioration of the law and order situation in the district due to their visit," the statement said.
